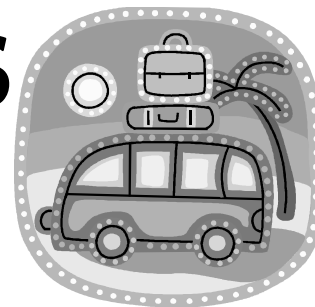


Summer Field Trips



1. **Bring a sack lunch**— a sack lunch is required for every field trip. Please also note that certain destinations will have a concession stand, where a member can purchase food. However, the staff will not be responsible for holding onto any money.
2. **Wear Sunscreen**— it would be in the best interest of everyone if you apply sunscreen to your child before you drop them off at the Club. It's also a good idea to send a bottle of sunscreen with them so they can apply any as needed throughout the day, spray bottle type sunscreen is what has worked best in the past. Please note: staff members cannot apply sunscreen. They will do their best to ensure your child has sunscreen on.
3. **Bring a change of clothes**— many of our field trips involve swimming of some kind. In order to ensure that all members are comfortable and healthy, we'll have them change out of their wet clothes before we depart the activity site.
4. **Wear Appropriate Footwear**— Make sure that your child is prepared to handle anything that we may encounter on any of our trips. Here are just a few things to keep in mind regarding footwear: sandals, flip-flops, or high heels are NOT acceptable for hiking trips, and socks are required at both the bowling alley and the skate way.
5. **Members must act appropriately at all times**— If a member does not handle themselves properly or does not comply with Club staff and rules, they may be unable to participate in future field trips without refund.
6. **Field Trips Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE**—in order to simplify the field trip process, all field trip registrations are final, please be sure of your choices.
7. **Seattle field trips**— We will try our best to return around 4:45p. However, due to traffic we may arrive back to the Club later than 4:45p. In the event that we will be late, we will call you ASAP. Please make certain we have your most current daytime contact information.
8. **Early Departure**—Please note that some field trips will depart at 9:00am, which is before the Club opens for drop-in hours (10:00am).
9. **Seattle Mariners Game**—we will stay at Safeco for the ENTIRETY of the game, so it would be best to discuss with your child whether or not they will be able to be comfortable sitting for a whole baseball game. Staying for the whole game also means that we may not return to Bellingham until much later than 4:30p
10. **Inclement Weather**— all outdoor field trips are subject to change due to bad weather. Please check in with any staff member to hear about any changes made to a certain field trip.
